## **PowerMEMS 2019 submission guidelines**

## Journal of Sensors and Actuators A: Physics

Participants are invited to submit manuscripts based on PowerMEMS 2019 conference presentations for possible publication in <u>Sensors and Actuators A: Physical</u> with the intention of publishing in a Special Issue that is dedicated to this meeting.

The Special Issue publication essentially rules out possible delays in publication for contributors to the special issue and will make this conference special issue more complete and accessible than it has ever been. Please see below its advantageous characteristics:

- > All submitted manuscripts will go through normal peer review process per journal standard;
- Accepted papers will be published individually as soon as they are accepted in earliest possible regular journal volumes at <u>Science Direct</u>, which ensures very fast publication speed for individual authors;
- There will be footnote included in each accepted paper, indicating at which conference it was presented;
- They will also be simultaneously added to the online Special Issue hosted at Science Direct, which is gradually built up as individual articles are published online;
- > Articles grouped together in the Special Issue will retain their original citation details.

All manuscripts will be subjected to the standard selection process for the journal, including the strict peer review procedure; therefore, acceptance for presentation at the meeting is not a guarantee for publication in the journal.
